Clerestory Opens 2014-15 Season with Luminous Night

Program of contemporary works with special guest the Magik*Magik Orchestra; Performances of Luminous Night to take place in San Francisco, Berkeley, and on *clerestory.org* via live streaming video.

San Francisco, CA, October 3, 2014 – Clerestory, the Bay Area's acclaimed nine-man vocal ensemble, begins its ninth season with *Luminous Night*, a program of contemporary music for chorus and instruments. Clerestory joins with the dynamic and innovative <u>Magik*Magik Orchestra</u> to illuminate 20th and 21st century music on themes of light and dark, death and love. Highlights include a world premiere of three new songs by Eric Banks setting romantic verse of Herman Melville, along with works by Shawn Crouch, Ola Gjeilo, and Eric Whitacre. *Luminous Night* also features John Corigliano's choral masterpiece, Fern Hill, to the poetry of Dylan Thomas. The concert includes music from the earliest days of European cathedrals to the Romantic masters who followed: Gregorian chant; Hildegard von Bingen; the Franco-Flemish Renaissance; and Brahms, Schumann and Poulenc. *Love and the Knight* will be performed several times throughout February, March, and April in San Francisco, Berkeley, Santa Rosa, Pleasanton, and Grass Valley. Songbook will be performed in Berkeley on May 30 and San Francisco on May 31.
